**Freeze-Dried:** Falling snowflakes, twenty-miles-an-hour wind and tendegrees-below temperature would not prevent Mom from her Saturday



morning ritual...washing clothes. In spite of the cold, the ringer washer and two tubs were filled to the proper level. While the water was running through the green water hose connected to the kitchen faucet, Mom sorted the clothes by colors, whites, and bed linens.

After the washer had completed its cycle and two rounds of rinsing, the clothes were placed in a basket and taken to the clothesline. Wooden pins were used to hold each item to the metal wires strung between two cross-shaped posts in the back yard. In the middle of the line, Mom had placed a board to help the sagging lines withstand the weight of the wet clothes.

The frigid air and whistling wind quickly froze the shirts, pants, under garments, and bed linens into odd shaped ice structures. Long before *Folgers* developed freeze-dried coffee, we had freeze-dried clothing. Later Mom would brave the cold attack of winter to remove the clothing from the icicle lines and take them into the house to be placed on hangers. Additional drying would take place near the wood stove or fireplace. When completely dried, Mom would iron the shirts and pants for future use.

Today, it is the almost forgettable *board* that catches my attention. The board was used to help support the clothes line and the clothes. Without it, the clothes would drag the ground, and the work would be ruined. God has provided many such gifts to assist us along our journey. The Church of the living God is one such aid in the support system. Likewise, the association is here to undergird the church in its mission endeavors. If your Christian experience is beginning to "sag", please allow your church to be a support of encouragement and strength to you.

Due to recent tragedies, the sagging spirits of surrounding communities have been evident. Raging wildfires and destructive winds have left their fingerprints on many lives. Your prayers, skills and generosity have been the "unseen board" that has brought support to numerous that were suffering. Thank you for being, giving and sharing the love of Christ.

After the Christmas holidays, many people experience an emotional and spiritual letdown. A sagging spiritual condition can be known to last long into winter. Some find themselves under house confinement because of freezing weather and short days. However, by braving the chilly blast of cold and attending the Sweetwater Baptist Association, Evangelism Conference at Fairview Baptist Tabernacle Church in Sweetwater on Monday evening, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, a spiritual "thawing" could be experienced. The Associational Choir will be singing and Dr. Johnny Hunt, Pastor of First Baptist Church, Woodstock, GA, will be the guest speaker. Prayerfully, we seek God to reenergize our evangelistic vision.

# **GUATEMALA MISSION PROJECT:**Recently the Tennessee Baptist

Recently the Tennessee Baptist Convention and Guatemala Baptist Convention confirmed plans for Sweetwater Baptist Association mission projects in Guatemala for 2017.



Notchey Creek will be returning to Guatemala, March 25-April 1, 2017. Projects have also been approved for June 23-30 for Bethlehem and Vonore. Tentative plans call for youth to serve on these mission teams, in addition to adult volunteers. This will be the second and/or third year mission volunteers will serve in an attempt to continue ministry work in the same locations of Guatemala where work was begun by teams in 2015.

An adult evangelism project has also been approved for September 15-22. Please contact the Sweetwater Baptist Association if you or your church is interested in serving on a revival mission team in Guatemala in 2017.

Tentative plans have now begun for the Sweetwater Baptist Association to participate in an evangelistic/music mission project in Guatemala in September, 2018. An Associational Choir would provide special music at the services. Please pray how God could use you to share the Gospel with the people in Guatemala.

Mission volunteers must have a valid passport and any required vaccinations from their doctor or health department. REMINDER FOR CHURCH
TREASURERS: The IRS requires
charitable organizations (including churches)
to provide written receipts for individual
donations of \$250.00 or more. For amounts



less than \$250.00, a written receipt is not required. However, it is recommended that churches provide an annual itemized statement to each contributor, regardless of the amount of donation. The statement should cover the January-December tax year and given to the contributor in a timely manner, for use in filing income tax returns. This written receipt should include the following information:

- 1) Name and address of the church;
- 2) Date and amount of each donation;
- Statement that no goods or services were given to individual making donation.

**TAX INFORMATION:** The Sweetwater Baptist Association Office has a supply of carbonless forms W2, W3, 1099 and 1096. These are available to our churches and are on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please stop by the SBA Office to pick up the forms that are needed for your church.




#### Please note important changes for 2017:

- (1) The due date for filing W2 and W3 forms with the SSA is JANUARY 31, 2017.
- (2) The due date for filing 1099 and 1096 with the IRS is JANUARY 31, 2017.
- (3) The rate for business travel reimbursement for 2017 is 0.53½¢ effective January 1<sup>st</sup>.
