REPORT FROM ANNUAL MEETING, 2022: Thank you Bethlehem Baptist Church and Pastor Zad Tomberlin for hosting Messengers as they gathered for the 192nd Session of the Sweetwater Baptist Association. Our Heritage Lives On was the theme for the 2022 Annual



Meeting. The opening welcome and prayer were presented by Pastor Zad Tomberlin. Wes Jones shared a word of greetings from

the Tennessee Baptist Mission Board, and presented a plaque behalf of churches of the Sweetwater Baptist Association that participate in the Golden Mission



Offering. The Memorial Report included Dedication of the 2022 Minutes of the Association in memory of former pastors: Rod Miller, Fred Beaty, Kenneth Johnson and Tyson Matoy. These men were beloved and faithful servants to this Association and our Lord. They will be sadly missed.

We thank our Moderator, Michael McLemore for his kind spirit and outstanding leadership this past year. In addition. Vice-Moderator Cardin Darrell did exceptional job in leading the Business Session. Items approved by Messengers



included: Darrell Cardin (Pastor of Christianburg) will serve as Moderator and David Lane (Pastor of Citico) was elected as Vice-Moderator for 2022-2023; and a proposed budget of \$203,269.00 was approved.

The Director of Missions Report indicated that churches have continued to be on mission here at home and around our world. Mission teams shared the Gospel of Christ in Iowa and Guatemala. Relief efforts, funds and supplies were shared in Tennessee, Kentucky and Ukraine. It was also reported that short-term mission projects are being planned for 2023.

We want to thank our host church, Bethlehem Baptist Church and Pastor Zad Tomberlin for the gracious welcome. 
