

your life. He called you to present Him to your congregation. What a joy and what a privilege! Dr. Joe McKeever shared an article that reminds pastors of the Sunday worship experience. The article is titled "The Top 12 Things for a Pastor to Remember just before Sunday Morning Worship." I want to share a portion of his article with you.

- Keep saying to yourself, "It's not about me." Jesus is the Savior, the Redeemer, the Lord, the Master, the Beginning and the End. Therefore, it is about Him.
- 2. **Relax, and remember to smile.** This is the hour you have planned for...delivering God's Word. You have fallen in love with Him. Share that love!
- Remember to worship. We have come to worship. Join the congregation as they worship and allow that worship to overflow in your preaching.
- Lead your congregation in prayer. This prayer should be real, so tell the Lord what you and the congregation need today. Pray positively knowing God can answer and bless.
- Trust God to do more than you have planned or asked. Never forget the Lord wants this worship service to succeed more than you ever will. His desire is to bring people to the Light.
- Expect the unexpected, even welcome it. God loves variety and delights in surprising us. The unexpected event might be heaven-sent.
- Do not undermine your effectiveness by constantly second-guessing yourself. You have learned to read the faces of your people as you preach. Sometimes that can be misleading. Stay focused on the gospel, not the faces.
- 8. Do not let yourself be tricked into discarding today's sermon for a message you feel more comfortable with.

 Stay with the plan, preacher. Trust the Lord. He walked with you all week and has not abandoned you this morning.
- Do not grade yourself on how well you did today. You are not your master, not your own professor and most definitely not your own grader. A servant stands or falls to his own master, Romans 14:4. This is the work of the Spirit. You are only His instrument.
- Trust Him. You would be surprised what He can do with nothing. He inspired a nation with a shepherd boy and a sling. He can do something with you and me, too. If we are willing to be small enough.
- 11. When they compliment you, at the conclusion of the service, be cool. They are not saying "that was the greatest

- sermon ever." They are being nice. Just say "thank you" and let it rest.
- 12. Resist the temptation to beat yourself up over the poor job you did. We all have had that experience. Get over it. Believe me, God can use our failures to do something great. You have another opportunity to plan for and the congregation will give you grace.

I would never begin to tell someone how or what to preach. That is up to the One who has called and gifted you. However, please allow me to encourage you to enjoy your journey. The task can be so overwhelming that we forget to rejoice in being His. I pray that you enjoy preaching more in 2018 than ever before.

REMINDER FOR CHURCH TREASURERS:

The IRS requires charitable organizations (including churches) to provide written receipts for individual donations of \$250.00 or more. For amounts less than \$250.00, a written receipt is not required. However, it is recommended that churches provide an annual itemized statement to each contributor, regardless of the amount of donation. The statement should cover the January December tax

However, it is recommended that churches provide an annual itemized statement to each contributor, regardless of the amount of donation. The statement should cover the January-December tax year and given to the contributor in a timely manner for use in filing income tax returns. Written receipts should include the following information:

- 1) Name and address of the church;
- 2) Date and amount of each donation;
- 3) Statement that no goods or services were given to individual making donation.
