Isn't it great; God is in control of our world! Sometimes it seems like things are so missed up no one truly understands what is happening. However, we can be



assured nothing takes God by surprise and everything will be used to give God the glory He deserves. With that in mind, the Sweetwater Baptist Association is planning a God-centered 2022. Covid has so impacted our churches that the baptism numbers have dropped off significantly. We are planning two events that will help churches recover from this correctable decline.

The first project will be Monday, March 21st at 7:00 p.m. The conference will be at the Sweetwater Baptist Association office in Madisonville. It is a "Who's Your One" workshop led by Chris Moore. This material combines prayer and an intentional approach to winning your friend, neighbor, and working acquaintance to the Lord. The material will be combined with "3 Circles" material which deals with "turning everyday conversations into Gospel conversations." Combining these studies will equip our people to share their personal experience with Jesus. We are also including the book "Tell Someone", by Greg Laurie. Our attempt is NOT to make anyone feel bad or condemn someone if they have not engaged others with the Gospel message. The material is written to encourage and inspire us to do what God has called each of us to do. We are making all this material available, at no charge, to the churches who attend. FREE!! The second project will be Monday, August 29th at 6:30 p.m. We are providing a Pastor, Deacon, and Wife workshop. We want to thank New Bethany Baptist Church in Sweetwater for hosting this event. Dr. Steve Holt, Church Services Director from the TBMB, will share how today's deacon can fulfill the biblical mandates of servanthood in the church. Included in the conference will be how the role of pastor and deacon are fellow-labors in kingdom building. Caregiving for the flock was and is the biblical principle of deacon service. That has not changed however, many young deacons fail to understand the proper functions of today's deacon. Also, Nancy Duggin will be accompanying Dr. Holt. She is a widow of a long-term deacon and will share the important role the wife plays in helping her husband be a successful deacon. To take the stress off of attending this meeting, we will provide a light meal to those who attend. Therefore, as time for the conference approaches, we will need you to RSVP.


