

I saw geese flying north the other day. Listening closely, I could hear the

The sounds of those who participated in the Senior Adult Christmas Celebration, Pastors and Wives Christmas Banquet, and the Financial Seminar still ring in our ear. Your laughter, "thank you," and "helpful" responses create encouragement for the Sweetwater Baptist Association. We had the largest gathering for the Senior Adult Christmas Celebration in several years, and the other events were pleasantly attended, as well. If you failed to attend any of these planned events, please consider marking your calendar for next year. Just as a well-placed "amen" lifts your pastor as he presents the Word of God, your presence at an associational event is a blessing to your associational staff.

We have much "flying" ahead of us in the coming year. Churches are now in the middle of receiving the *Guatemala Project Offering*. Pastor Fred and The Lamb of God Baptist Church in Las Mercedes is in dire need of a cistern covered, bathrooms, and the floor finished. Our Association approved a goal of \$25,000 to assist in completing this project in our *2022 Annual Meeting*. Prayerfully, this goal will be reached and surpassed. Your faithfulness in giving continues to bring joy to our hearts.

Churches are also "soaring" in preparation for Vacation Bible School. The first ever Associational VBS Showcase is scheduled for Tuesday, March 7 at 6:30. The Showcase will be held at the associational office and examples of five choices of materials will be available for your consideration. This method of VBS Clinic provides each church with a greater selection of materials to choose from. We have noticed churches are using alternative studies than the recommended issue from Lifeway. We are here to serve you and therefore want to expand our VBS selection to better meet the needs of our churches.

Mission activities are moving forward as we journey through the summer. Trips to Guatemala and Iowa are being planned, and teams are already being formed. The beauty of God's world is not only seen from above, but also in the eyes, heart, and soul of people laboring together on mission. The spiritual blessing cannot be described but only experienced by serving our Master on mission. I hope you have the privilege of serving God on mission sometime this

summer. You do not have to journey abroad to be a missionary, we all live on a mission field!

Finally, sometime ago your pastor received a letter from me explaining I am facing another round of cancer. Five years ago, I had part of my right kidney removed because of cancer. Since that time, I have done fine. However, over the Christmas holidays, I was diagnosed with prostate cancer. Because of the previous experience with cancer, the doctors strongly suggest I have the prostate removed to prevent any return of cancer. I concur with the physician's findings and will be having surgery March 8th. I have met with the Mission Committee, and they have encouraged me to take up to 3 months leave with pay. This should allow time to recover and resume my work for our Savior and our churches. (I do not think it will take the entire time before I am back in the office.) The greatest blessing from the meeting with the Mission Committee was their commitment to pray for me as they expressed their love and support. I will long remember how they lifted me above the cloud of cancer. I covet your prayers that the cancer is contained, and the surgeon's abilities are directed by God's Spirit. Thank you in advance for your love and support.

shoe-molding and trim, all electrical, plumbing, final painting, closet shelving, and pantry shelving are complete! Furniture, beds, blinds, are installed, TVs are mounted, and the *Giving Room* is organized! They are just waiting for the weather to cooperate to have driveway and sidewalks poured. Once that is complete, the fence, playground, sod and landscaping can all be completed so a ribbon cutting can be scheduled. The house will be used as a place for children to stay while waiting for placement in foster care. The house is located at the intersection of County Road 517 and 519 in Englewood. MYANMAR WELLS UPDATE: At last report (thru funds provided by the churches of the Sweetwater Baptist Association) 30 water wells have been dug in Myanmar! This is during a time of civil unrest and military harassment in the country.


