



**ANCHORED!** The gulf waters seemed quite calm for the first two days. The

expression "as smooth as glass" definitely came to mind. Of all the things I noticed around the beach, two yellow buoys caught my attention. They appeared to float upon the waters. They were used to indicate the area for water sports such as jet skiing, parasailing, and banana boat rides.

During the third night a weather front moved through the area, and the coastline was being assaulted by wave after wave. The storm was churning up the gulf floor. The waves were white capping, and sand could be seen mixed with salt water. The waves were crashing ashore one after another. I noticed the two yellow buoys being jerked and turned by the active waves. They were driven toward the shore and then pulled by the riptide toward the open gulf only to be swallowed by the next wave. Yet the buoys never moved far from where they were anchored. This made me think of God's love for me. Our lives are often as agitated as stormy waters. God does not promise us smooth sailing. Instead, we will encounter rejection, illness, death, separation, and a thousand other storms. Yet God promises, that if we cast all our anxieties/fears on Him, He cares for us and we never have to face these trials alone.

God creates in each of us a desire to participate by being anchored to the gospel. The 2025 Ministry Summit (Evangelism Conference) will be an excellent opportunity for allowing God to strengthen and encourage the saint; it will be held Saturday, February 22 at Notchey Creek Baptist Church. There will be a morning session and an evening worship rally. The morning speakers will be Dr. Roc Collins, Dr. Phil Hoskins, and Dr. Randy Davis. The activities will begin with breakfast at 8:00 a.m. with the Morning Session to follow. The Evening Worship Rally will begin at 7:00 p.m. with preaching by Dr. Roc Collins. The Notchey Creek Baptist Church Praise and Music teams will provide the special music for both sessions.

The month of March will be packed with great opportunities to be anchors for Vacation Bible School. The *VBS Showcase* will be on Monday, March 10 from 3:00-7:00 p.m. at the Association Office. There will be five VBS kits to examine for your church consideration. They are *Rocket Racers, Wonder Junction, Road Trip, Magnified*, and *Australian Adventure*. This is an excellent time to "batten down the hatches" and prepare for an exciting summer.

March also provides an opportunity to gain experience in how God is using the members of the SBA to win the lost. 
