

Director Missions

Spring causes me to reminisce about

days gone by. As I look out my backdoor, it becomes easy to allow my mind the privilege of a journey to simpler times. With my recent struggles from COVID 19, Darnell's hip surgery, and all the constant restrictions placed on us, one hopes for better days. I accept this is the day God has placed me, and I am prepared to serve Him joyfully. However, a mini vacation of the mind can offer temporary relief from the distractions of our day.

I see out my backdoor, daffodils lining the street, as they push toward heaven. The apple tree beside the house hosts thousands of blooms, and the two maple trees in the front yard are clothed in new greenery. The wood stack has a few sticks of wood, while only small rock-size pieces of coal remain in the pile. The brown grass is slowly turning green. In a short time, a push mower with rotating metal bars will clip the new growth. Whippoorwill and Blackberry Winter will keep the sting of the chilly season with us for a few more weeks. Spring is slowly making its way into East Tennessee.

As a boy, I could generate a small *nest egg* through weeks of selling the *Sweetwater Valley News* at ten cents a copy. Seven cents per newspaper belonged to the newspaper office, while three cents were pure profit. On Wednesday afternoon, the town swarmed with several young boys selling the news.

March is kite flying season and a portion of my profit was used to purchase a kite and string. The kite would cost ten cents and several rolls of string would be bought for another dime. The neighboring field was ideal for kite flying. There were no power lines or trees nearby for the kite to get entangled. On a windy day, several boys would gather for the fun.

To make the kite fly better, a tail was added. Material from mom's clothing scraps was perfect. The object was to see who could get their kite to fly the highest. Sometimes the kite string would break, and the kite would be lost forever. At other times, the kite would be so high it would be hard to see, especially as darkness enveloped the flying amusement. It was great lying on your back, chewing on a piece of straw grass, looking toward heaven. Occasionally, you would pull on the string to feel

the kite. A gentle tug was all it took to let us know the kite was still up there. That is the way it is with God. Occasionally, He gives a gentle tug on our heart's string to let us know that He is still there.

Time travels quickly between Christmas and Easter, a short three or four months. Yet these two dates represent an eternity of time. Easter provides us hope for everlasting life, an unending season of freedom from COVID 19, hip surgeries, and restrictions. It will be a privilege to "live in a land where we never grow old." By being in the presence of our risen Savior, Jesus Christ, we will experience a continued renewing of living life at its fullest. I hope your church will find ways to make this Easter special.

I hope you have taken a mini vacation with me. If I had three cents today when I heard from heaven, I would have a small *nest egg*. Come to think of it, God keeps the other seven cents in heaven. It is going to be great news someday when we all swarm home.






mission projects in *Guatemala for 2021*. Project dates are set for June 22-29 and September 14-21. Rules have changed for travel in and out of Guatemala. Proof of negative COVID tests will be required for travel in and out of the United States. Mission volunteers must have a valid passport, as well as any required vaccinations from their doctor or health department. Teams must be held to a maximum of 15 mission volunteers.



Fort Sherman Academy Travel Security Training is required for all volunteers participating in upcoming mission projects in Guatemala. This online security training is

valid for 2 years.

The Tennessee Baptist Mission Board requires all participants to attend an orientation training, as well as *More-Life*, crosscultural, security, travel safety, and child protection training. Much of the training is available online or at the Sweetwater Baptist Association Office. Training dates will be scheduled as soon as possible.



#### **CHURCH** MUSIC STREAMING/

LICENSING ISSUES: Some of churches have reported problems with presentation of special music during livestreaming of services. This occurs especially when the special music is being



provided by either purchased performances tracks and/or iTunes purchased performance tracks. This challenging problem was forwarded to the Worship and Music Specialists of the Tennessee Baptist Mission Board for their assistance: and we thank them for their feedback and help in this matter. If your church is experiencing this problem, here is their response to possibly handling the situation.

First, the good news...CCLI (www.ccli.com) offers a new solution to legally stream "accompaniment tracks." It's called the Streaming License Plus. If you contact them directly, they'll take care of you, or you can sign up online. There is a cost, starting at around \$210 per year. As I understand, this license would be in addition to having the standard Christian Copyright License through CCLI.

Now, the bad news...Even when you have permission to legally stream recorded music (such as through the Streaming License Plus referenced above), Facebook's algorithms will sometimes still "block" and "flag" your services when they hear those tracks, because Facebook has no way to know consistently that you have permission to play these recordings. They will usually remove the "flag" once you let them know


about your permission, but it can still take time and be a frustrating process.


