

UPDATE FROM EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING: The Executive Board of the Sweetwater Baptist Association met on Monday evening, April 16th. We want to thank Pastor Jeremy McNally and Island Creek Baptist Church for hosting the meeting.



Greg McCosh served as Moderator for the regular business meeting for the Association. Union Grove Baptist Church and Union McMinn Baptist Church were welcomed as first-time participating member congregations. Reports from various ministries of the Association, as well as the Director of Missions Report were presented for information. The Evangelism Committee reported that they were currently working on a 2-night *Evangelism Conference* for 2019.

The Associational Treasurer's report was received as printed. The financial statement reported that church gifts and interest for October 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018 totaled \$94,416.51; while budget expenses totaled \$81,435.14.

Items presented for business and approved by Executive Board Members included: (1) Recommendation from Program Committee to suspend rules of *Constitution and Bylaws* of the Sweetwater Baptist Association in regards to the Annual Meeting in order to allow Annual Meeting, 2018 to be held as a one-day event; and (2) Recommendation from Missions Committee that the petition request for membership from Delano Baptist Church (Interim Pastor, Dennis Cagle) be accepted in accordance with Procedures for Petitioning the Sweetwater Baptist Association, and that Delano Baptist Church be taken under the watch-care of the Sweetwater Baptist Association for one year, pending the vote of Messengers at the 2019 Annual Meeting. Representatives from Delano Baptist Church in attendance were recognized and welcomed to the meeting.


