Obedience is to hear God's Word and act accordingly. The word

translated "obey" in the Old Testament means "to hear" and is often translated that way. In the New Testament, several words describe obedience. One word means "to hear or to listen in a state of submission." Another New Testament word often translated "obey" means "to trust." The person's obedient response to God's Word is a response to trust or faith. Thus, to really hear God's Word is to obey God's Word.

In the early days of the Sweetwater Baptist Association, visions of new church starts and to strengthen existing churches was the major point of focus. Church growth and church plants spread throughout the Monroe County area. The congregations have grown from small family gatherings to community worship centers. Circuit riding preachers have been replaced with a pastor leading a single congregation.

Obedience has long been a goal of the Sweetwater Baptist Association. Answering the call of God's Word has led the people who live in the foothills of the Smoky Mountains to travel around the world sharing the love of God. The handprint of God can be seen in the churches of the Ukraine, Brazil and Panama. Thirst has been quenched in Haiti, where wells of water have brought forth life. Now, an orphanage is being built on the poorest island in the Northern Hemisphere, Haiti.

Obedience has an effect on our spiritual life; it calls us to worship God. The obedience of faith brings about salvation, and secures God's blessing on His children. Spiritual insight is gained through obedience; a life of obedience to God is the fruit of faith. True obedience means imitating God in holiness, humility and love. His disciples do the will of the Father. Obedience leaves the handprint of God on each person we share His love.

Twenty years of service and obedience is worthy of acknowledgement. Ms. Audrey Stephens has been our Associational WMU Director for two decades. She has seen much change and improvement in the mission efforts of the Sweetwater Baptist Association during her tenure as director. 


