The SBA family has a long partnership with the people of Ukraine. Our Association has invested money, prayers, and service to the people of Ukraine. Since the 1990's, mission teams from this Association have traveled to do missions in Ukraine. After they became an independent nation in 1991, Bethlehem Baptist Church funded one of the first Baptist seminaries there. Union McMinn Baptist Church funded a medical clinic. Both of these institutions are still in operation today. The Association's investment is still serving Ukrainians today. Those relationships will endure time, struggle, war, and Satan's attack. Please continue to pray for God's protection over these wonderful people. We also want to express gratitude to our churches for generously giving funds and supplies to aid the people in Ukraine and to the refugees that have fled to Poland, Moldova and Israel.

Our churches are knee-deep into Vacation Bible School planning. VBS is equivalent to a children's revival. Your church is given an opportunity to share Jesus with many unfamiliar faces. Loving these children opens the door to follow-up into their homes. What an excellent opportunity VBS provides for sharing God's Word and His Love with our community. IOWA MISSIONS: Several of our churches will be participating in mission opportunities in our communities, across our state and country during the next few weeks.



A partnership mission team from the Sweetwater Baptist Association will be traveling to **lowa**, **July 16-23**. These volunteers will work with local pastors and churches in a community near lowa City called Downey. The team will join in Vacation Bible School, revivals and door-to-door witnessing.

Please remember this mission team, as well as all other mission teams from our churches, as they share the love of Christ in our communities, across our state, country, and world.

GUATEMALA: The Tennessee Baptist Mission Board (TBMB) and Guatemala Baptist Convention have confirmed plans for the Sweetwater Baptist Association mission project in *Guatemala for 2022*. A team from Bethlehem and Birchfield



(Blount County) will be returning to continue on-going mission work with pastors and people of Guatemala. The project dates are **June 21-28**.

New COVID-related entry requirements have just been announced by the US Embassy for Guatemala! All travelers must present one of the following: (a) Evidence of receiving a complete 2-dose COVID vaccination course (or 1 dose Johnson & Johnson), with the final dose being administered at least 2 weeks before beginning the trip to Guatemala or (b) Proof of negative COVID PCR or antigen test from a certified lab conducted no more than 3 days prior to check-in at the airport.

This means there is no longer a vaccination requirement. And if you are vaccinated, you will not need an additional COVID-19 test. You only need one or the other.

Mission volunteers must have a valid passport, as well as any required vaccinations from their doctor or health department. Teams must be held to a maximum of 15 mission volunteers.

FORT SHERMAN TRAINING is required for all volunteers participating in upcoming mission projects in Guatemala. This online security training is valid for 2 years. In addition to the Fort Sherman Travel Security,



the Tennessee Baptist Mission Board requires all participants to complete online evangelistic, cross-cultural, and child protection training.

Recently many of our churches responded to the call to help fill the Sweetwater Baptist Association disaster relief trailer with items to aid Ukrainian refugees. These items were delivered to the distribution center in Chattanooga, as part of the Tennessee Baptist Mission Board Disaster Relief for Ukraine to assist refugees in two (2) projects. One was to help fill a container for the country of Moldova, which is a small country of 1.5 million people and has taken in over 300,000 refugees. The second project was to assist pregnant mothers and mothers with children (up to 5 years of age) fleeing to Israel from Ukraine. Many of these young mothers with children escaped Ukraine with only the clothes they were wearing. A vast number of these refugees are being relocated in Israel.

Thank you churches for always being generous supporters of missions. Please continue to pray for the Ukraine nation and the people of Ukraine.

JUST A NOTE: I have been blessed to have two homelands. Ukraine was the place of my birth, as well as where I learned of Christ, and accepted Him as my Lord and Savior. Now, the United States of America (and



Tennessee) is my home where I reside with my loving family and friends.



Still, Ukraine is not forgotten. I want to ask you to please pray that the Word of God will continue to be shared with the people of Ukraine. Pray that seeds will be sown, and souls will be saved. Please pray for my
