Summer is winding down, school has started back. There is something about having a



healthy routine that brings order to chaos. For most of us, a typical summer has us on the go from early daylight to well past sundown. That also describes the activity around the Sweetwater Baptist Association.

Vacation Bible Schools have dominated the time schedule for many of our congregations. "In the Wild" and other themes have brought the teaching of Jesus to many young hearts. Thousands of boys and girls were touched because of your involvement. The adult investment of time and wisdom in the lives of children accrues a benefit in eternity. Thank you for sharing Jesus' love with these little ones.

Summer is also a time for mission trips and special activities. The Sweetwater Baptist Association was represented in Guatemala in June. The team led by Bethlehem Baptist Church provided VBS and other activities for school children, conducted door-to-door visitation, sponsored a medical clinic and preached nightly in churches and mission sites. The weather may have been the hottest on record, however, the testimony of those being introduced to Jesus leaves a lasting impression.

The Sweetwater Baptist Association also joined with Reed Springs Baptist Church in July on a journey to lowa. In the small community of Downey, the team conducted a Vacation Bible School, preformed small construction projects and held a revival. It was an exciting experience to watch the young southern people relate to the older congregation in lowa. The outreach to the children and youth was priceless. It is powerful to see the kingdom of God come together to birth a blessing to a community.

The Union McMinn Baptist Church will be returning to Guatemala in September. Last year they adopted a church in Colombia, Guatemala. The Church is called Las Mercedes. God is truly blessing Pastor Fred and the congregation. The church has doubled in size this past year. God has truly used the team from Union McMinn to bless this church. This year I will join twenty-two others on the mission team. We will work with school children, conduct a Vacation Bible School, sponsor a Medical Clinic, and preach nightly. I wish I could adequately describe to you where God has brought Las Mercedes from and where He is leading them. It confirms that God is still doing great and mighty things!

The SBA Youth Committee did a great job planning this summer's Youth Reach conference. Everyone seemed to enjoy having a new band lead the praise and worship, and the young ladies from Cane Creek did a great job sharing in song. Many decisions were made to draw closer to the Lord, and encouragement was exalted from Pastor Andrew Osakue. We live in a world that is filled with all manner of discouragement and temptation for our young people. It is encouraging to witness students in our association worshipping and growing in their relationship with Christ.

During the 2018 Annual Meeting, the Messengers voted to raise funds for a local tiny house to benefit the homeless in our community.

You did an excellent job of raising over \$24,000.00. Two tiny houses will be built this year and placed on sites to be used to house the homeless in our area. This year, God has placed it on my heart to ask our churches to help provide clean water to a village in Myanmar. Wells can be drilled, and pumps added for \$600.00 each. Jesus said, "and whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these little ones a cup of cold water only in the name of a disciple, verily I say unto you, he shall in no wise lose his reward." The children of one village in Myanmar have NEVER had a cup of clean cold water. The only clear water they get is rainwater caught in barrels. Never have they bathed or washed cloths in clean water. We can drill 10 wells for \$6,000.00. Our giving would bless an entire village. I will present this project to our churches at our Annual Meeting in October.

As summer turns to autumn and then winter, the cycle of reaching people and touching lives will continue to bring honor and glory to His Holy Name. Please continue in prayer for the churches of the Sweetwater Baptist Association and His ministries.


The purpose of this conference is to equip, train and strengthen church leadership and church workers. Valuable information and training will be offered for all church leaders.

different areas of Guatemala by new teams. If you are interested in serving on a 2020 mission team in Guatemala, please contact the Sweetwater Baptist Association.




