

The hot, hazy, humid days of August usually means that the pestilent days of flu are far behind us.



Typically, teams would have returned from

Guatemala and Iowa, while Vacation Bible Schools are put to rest. Due to COVID-19, this summer has been like no other. Churches are struggling on how to effectively reach the lost of our communities. Many churches are attempting to relaunch in-person worship. Presently, we have several churches who are combating this dreaded outbreak within their fellowship. Many have turned to 2 Chronicles for the solution to this dilemma, "If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."

It is easy for us to look to the lost perverted generation around us and say, "It is your fault." However, read the above verse again. It is addressed to the children of God, not to the "Gentile." This scripture is addressed to the church of today. You and I profess to be His people. Therefore, we are the one who needs to repent, fall on our face seeking God's grace and forgiveness. We are summoned to turn and seek a refreshing way of life that God can use to impact our world for His glorification. The Good Father still desires to pour His blessings on His Children, bring a restored relationship, and prosper His Kingdom. Although, we need to remember that we exist in a real world that is broken. Christianity offers a life of suffering and often struggles. To deny this is to deny the teaching of Jesus, who calls us to bear a cross not a recliner.

We often assemble with only smoldering embers, flames are extinguished, souls are parched, and emotions are drained to empty. Countless days have turned to weeks and years without a cry to the Lord. Now is the time for a "fresh wind" from above to blow over the embers that glow, souls that thirst, and emotions to praise the LORD. We look for singing and preaching to bring about this revival. However, again reread the verse above. God calls us to humble ourselves, pray, seek, and turn then God responds. Sounds like an invitation to simply fall on our face and call out to Jesus. This is not a shouting hallelujah "worship experience." It is a soul searching, repenting, being broken Isaiah 6 confrontation before the Lord, who is high and lifted. Get it? The angels are singing, God is inviting Isaiah into His presence, and Isaiah understands that He is not worthy, Isaiah does not speak until God grants permission, and his words reflect his unworthiness of being in the presence of God. I believe this is God's answer to the question of what should we do?

My heart is broken for the path our present world situation has placed you and the congregation you may serve. However, I believe that God already knew of this virus before it was released in China. I also believe that He knows your character and your coping abilities. We are not on this journey alone. My God promises that He will never leave or forsake His Children. All that God is, is available for us to draw from and lean on, if we incorporate God's principles in our lives.

Public prayer does not seek to accomplish what private communion with God can accomplish. I have been guilty of simply going through the motions and saying words but failing to be broken before the Lord God Almighty, Creator, Wonderful Savior. For that and so much more, I REPENT! --- Tony Rutherford
