I am writing this in what the Old Timers used to call the "dog days of August." The weather report calls for a



temperature of 97 degrees tomorrow. No matter

where you are, that is hot! The air is stifling, and the breeze lacks cooling qualities. However, autumn activities are just around the corner. The SBA office is planning for the *Church Growth & Development Conference*, *Pastor & Family Picnic*, 2021 Annual Meeting, as well as the Christmas activities. Elsewhere in the newsletter, you will find dates and time for all these events.

I have heard from several churches about revivals that are happening and the results of Vacation Bible Schools. It is encouraging to know God is pouring out His blessings on the efforts of our congregations. Many are reporting that numbers of professions of faith are up, and the spirit of the worshippers are glowing. One congregation shared their plans for a baptism, the first in several years. Let us give God a PRAISE! After a year and a half of isolation, God is ordaining a period of harvest. Let us glean from the fields in which He has planted us and enjoy the refreshing that only comes from Him.

Your generosity toward the mission opportunities over the past decade has been beyond expectations. Several years ago, you adopted children in Haiti following a devastating earthquake. While feeding and sheltering the children, you raised approximately \$140,000 to build an all-purpose facility housing a church and school. The five-year commitment has resulted in many lives rescued and saved.

We are now in our sixth year of partnership ministry in Guatemala where hundreds have professed Christ as Savior. Two churches have been built, and several more supported. An ongoing relationship has proven to be successful in "the land of volcanos." These beautiful people are eager to hear the glorious Gospel of Christ, which is refreshing to our teams from America. This would be an excellent opportunity to send a pastor who has little to no experience in dealing with international missions. We would be glad to help!

Simultaneously, the SBA has traveled to lowa to work with several churches over the past 10 years. These trips have consisted of small construction teams, VBS teams, and revival efforts. This is an excellent opportunity to train future leaders in struggling communities, while introducing Jesus to areas where there is little to no outreach. Many of our mid-western and northern states have become rich grounds for sharing Christ. Let us help you plan now to minister next summer with a congregation deeply in need of help.

Besides these *on-the-field* projects, your love for Christ has reached to the homeless here in Monroe County by building two *tiny houses*. These homes are located in Sweetwater and are maintained by the *Homeless Coalition of Monroe County*. Furthermore, you are helping to build a home, thru the *Isaiah 117* project, for children in the McMinn/Monroe County area who are separated from their families. Innocent, defenseless, and vulnerable children will soon have a safe place to discover that they are loved. In addition, in the tiny southeast Asian country of Myanmar, you are helping to feed a

starving church congregation and drilling wells of fresh water, as the Gospel of Christ is offered with each cup of clean water.

Proposed budget changes for 2021-2022:

 Increase in salary line items by near 3%, rounding to dollar amounts. The following are recommended:



- (a) Increase DOM Salary/Housing by \$835.00
- (b) Increase DOM Benefits by \$600.00
- (c) Increase Administrative Assistant Salary by \$849.00
- (d) Increase Ministry Assistant Salary by \$728.00
- (e) Increase Staff Social Security by \$123.00 (to reflect staff salary increases)

Working Agreements authorize yearly salary increases, if funds are available.

- 2. Section II. Associational Organizations
- (a) Increase Student/Youth Ministry by \$2500.00 or a total of \$5000.00 (*Connect* Youth Rally)
- 3. Section II. Associational Office Maintenance
 - (a) Increase Insurance (Office) by \$1700.00 or a total of \$5000.00 (Office Insurance Policy Increase)

The proposed overall budget INCREASE is \$7,335.00 or a total budget of \$193.558.00.

This is a proposed budget increase of 3.94%.


