We had the privilege to visit many Vacation Bible Schools this year. We apologize we were unable to visit all of the schools at the churches. June of 2022 also allowed us to return to the mission field. Four of our mission ambassadors served eight days in Guatemala. It was an immense pleasure to represent our 74 churches to the wonderful people of Guatemala who are eager to receive Christ as their Lord and Savior. On

this trip, 2 people prayed to begin their relationship with Jesus, and there were several rededications. Also, the mission team

there were several rededications. Also, participated in the baptism of two new converts. Several home visits were made, leaving a message of God's love with numerous potential brothers and sisters. Two nights were given to revival services where the building was packed each evening. A construction project was completed with the pouring of concrete and the painting of a kitchen area for the church at El Canal. This



group was truly blessed to serve alongside people in Guatemala who are eager to worship, serve, and demonstrate the love of God.



July provided the opportunity for 21 people from 6 different churches to serve in lowa together. In West Branch, lowa, Vacation Bible School was conducted, construction projects were completed, and a revival was provided for the

people of Downey Baptist Church. Laboring in love to strengthen the Church of Christ is a noble and worthy challenge. It is often eye

opening for people from a "Bible-believing" south to travel and work with Christians in the mid-western states. While we often have one or two revivals a year in our churches, yet three years ago was the first revival in Downey Baptist Church in 80+ years. Often the question is asked "Why would you come so fai



asked, "Why would you come so far, spend so much, and give so graciously to strangers?" The answer is Christ!

As we turn our attention to August, the *Old-Fashioned Prayer Meeting* will be held at Old Sweetwater Baptist Church on Highway 11 in Sweetwater. Dr. Lon Shoopman will be preaching the message, while the Big Creek Singers will provide the special music.

This is a time to worship, pray, and seek God's direction for the churches of the Sweetwater Baptist Association. The 74 churches that make up the Association have agreed to provide missions and evangelism to our community. at 10:30 a.m. This is a free event; and all ages are invited.



- (d) Increase Pastor Ministry by \$700.00 or a total of \$3000.00 (provides Pastor/Family picnic, Pastor/Wife Christmas and Memorial Bibles for death)
- (e) Increase Utilities by \$700.00 or a total of \$3750.00 (increase in cost of Water/Electric)

- (f) Increase DOM by \$2600.00 (\$850.00 Salary; \$850.00 Housing; \$600.00 Retirement; \$300.00 Christmas Gift)
- (g) Increase Administrative by \$1800.00 (\$269.00 Salary; \$1300.00 Retirement; \$300.00 Christmas Gift)
- (h) Increase Ministry Assistant by \$1600.00 (\$1300.00 Salary; \$300.00 Christmas Gift)
- (i) Increase Staff Social Security by \$261.00 or a total of \$5092.00 (reflects increase due to increase in salaries)

churches have provided baby items, household items, clothes, toys and monetary gifts. Items are still being accepted for these families as they make their homes here in East Tennessee. Our Resident Interpreter, Svitlana Self is assisting with the distribution of things given to our office for these families. Here is information we have available for the families:

- (1) Ukraine family of 5 live with a host family in Tellico Plains area (father, mother, 3 children: ages 6, 4 and 2 with another baby due in August)
- (2) Ukraine family of 4 live in rental apartment in Cleveland area (father, mother, 2 children: ages 4 and 19 mos.)
- (3) Ukraine family of 5 live in mission house until August 1<sup>st</sup> in Cleveland area (father, mother, 3 children: ages 6, 4, 12 mos.)

Even though these families were brought to our area as part of a government refugee program, they are still waiting for important paperwork to be processed and finalized which is a time-consuming process. Please remember these families in your prayers.

Thank you churches for ministering to those displaced and impacted by the crisis in Ukraine. Thank you for always being generous supporters of missions. Please continue to pray for the Ukraine nation and the people of Ukraine.




