"For whosoever shall give you a cup of water to drink in my name, because ye belong to Christ, verily I say unto you, he shall not lose his reword." (Mark 9:41)



shall not lose his reward." (Mark 9.41). The Sweetwater Baptist Association will be going beyond the second mile in *cups of water* because of the action taken in the 189th Annual Meeting held at Union-McMinn Baptist Church. The Association voted to set **Sunday, February 16, 2020** as a special day to collect an offering to drill water wells in Myanmar. The minimum goal of \$6,000.00 will provide 10 wells in a village that presently has no clean water. Any funds collected above the \$6,000.00 (and after an adequate number of water wells have been drilled) will be used to help the children in the local school and church in Myanmar.

Jesus realized that the simple act of a cup of water would open people up to receiving the Gospel. Something we in America take for granted is often a high-priced commodity in other parts of the world. The action taken has the potential to introduce an entire village to the love of Jesus Christ. Simply sharing His love by providing a cup of water is extremely rewarding.

A cup doesn't hold very much. However, we are reminded of the boy with two fishes and 5 loaves of bread (John 6:9) that Jesus used to feed 5,000 men plus the women and children. Just imagine what God can do with ten water wells! The woman at the well (John 4:4-42) shared the Good News to her village over a request from Jesus for a *cup of water*. The woman discovered *love* that literally changed her life. The reward in heaven may be that someone from a village in Myanmar will approach you and say, "thank you for giving so I could sip from a cup of clean, fresh water and there I found Christ that loved me so."

The spirit of fellowship and oneness that brought us to Union-McMinn Baptist Church filled the sanctuary and caused our *cups to overflow*. The business session was marked with unity as having all things in common. The music was heavenly as Jesus was lifted and our hearts produced tears flowing from our eyes. Together we worshipped and raised our hands to praise the Savior. Jesus drank from the bitter cup in the Garden of Gethsemane so we might drink out of the overflow of blessings. Brother Bud Boring poured his heart out as he shared in sermon concerning the Unity of God's Church. The singleness of the church was evident as the Spirit of God refreshed our souls.

Witnessing the fellowship and excitement as people departed the building, there was an enthusiasm about facing the future. If God delays His return, we expect to accomplish great tasks in the coming days, weeks, months, and years. It is humbling to consider what God has in store for His children as they surrender to His divine will. God is only limited by our lack of trust and inward glance. I plead for your prayers and support as God does ministry in far greater terms than we can accomplish. May God's grace and mercy be upon us all.

REPORT FROM ANNUAL MEETING, 2019: What a great time of worship, as Messengers gathered for the 189th Session of the Sweetwater Baptist Association. "The Pathway Home" was the theme for the 2019 Annual Meeting.



The Moderator's Message was presented

by Charles "Bud" Boring, Pastor, Cedar Fork Baptist Church. He shared Scripture from Ephesians and encouraged Messengers to unite and walk worthy of the calling. A special thank you to our Moderator for his humble spirit and outstanding leadership this past year. Special music was provided by the Associational Choir and led by Phillip Johnson. Janice Carter shared a word of greetings from the Tennessee Baptist



Mission Board and presented a plaque to the Sweetwater Baptist Association on behalf of churches of the Association that participated in the Golden Mission Offering.

The Memorial Report included Dedication of the 2019

Minutes of the Association in memory of retired or former pastors, Samuel Boone, Charles Cassady, Randy Irons and Bruce Poplin. These men were dearly beloved and faithful servants to this Association and our Lord. They will be sadly missed.

Our Vice-Moderator, Mitch Ingram did an outstanding job in leading the Business Session. Items approved by Messengers included to replace the current *Constitution and Bylaws of the Sweetwater Baptist Association*; churches to provide funds to drill water wells in Myanmar; and a proposed budget of \$181,616.00 was



approved. Mitch Ingram (Pastor of Lakeside) will serve as Moderator for 2019-2020 and Lewis Jones (Pastor of Island Creek) was elected as Vice-Moderator for 2019-2020. Delano Baptist Church was accepted as a member church; Pastor Jamie Johnson and members of the congregation were in attendance and were recognized and welcomed.

Items presented by Director of Missions, Tony Rutherford, included a recommendation that was approved for the churches to fund the drilling of 10 water wells in the country of Myanmar, with an approximate cost of \$600.00 for each well. Also, on behalf of the Constitution Committee, he presented the recommendation for the new proposed *Constitution and By-Laws of the Sweetwater Baptist Association*. Among other various changes, three noticeable changes were made in the new *Constitution and By-Laws of the Sweetwater Baptist Association*. They were:

- Number of voting Messengers allowed for each participating member church at the Annual Meeting;
- Voting requirements for participating member churches; and
- Procedures for new church admissions.

The 2019 Associational Minutes will include a copy of the complete, new Constitution and Bylaws that was adopted by Messengers at the 2019 Annual Meeting.

We want to thank 200+ Pastors, Messengers and visitors from churches represented that were in attendance for the sessions. We want to thank the host church, Union McMinn Baptist Church and Pastor Doug Alexander. We also want to thank the Program Committee, and everyone on the program that helped make this year's *Annual Meeting* a blessed time of worship. Please pray for the Program Committee as they plan and prepare for *Annual Meeting*, 2020.

MYANMAR: Myanmar (also known as Burma) is one of the poorest countries located in the western portion of Southeast Asia. In the country, over 9.7 million people have no clean water. Would your church please be part of providing fresh, clean water for the people in the country of Myanmar? We are asking that the churches



of the Sweetwater Baptist Association receive a love offering for drilling water wells for Myanmar by **Sunday**, **February 16th**. Please watch for further details or contact the Sweetwater Baptist Association if you are interested in further information regarding the mission work in Myanmar.

GUATEMALA MISSION MINISTRY:

During the past year, numerous shortterm mission volunteers traveled to Guatemala as part of the on-going Tennessee Baptist Mission Board partnership in Guatemala. The June team from Bethlehem reported 10 professions



of faith, with approximately 200 people being provided free medical assistance. The September team from Union McMinn reported 267 professions of faith, and 292 receiving free medical assistance.

Would you like to be part of the mission ministry in Guatemala? Volunteers are needed in 2020 to serve as preachers at revivals and crusades, as well as laypersons to serve on medical and dental teams.



We are also hopeful teams

will return in 2020 to continue ministry projects and/or do further work in areas where ministry focus has already been established. Additional teams are needed to do work in the new ministry locations of Guatemala. 
