EQUIP THE SAINTS: When my son Justin was younger, I enjoyed coaching his



baseball and basketball teams. Coaching allowed me to meet new people, and it also

allowed me to teach the fundamentals of the game. Those fundamentals were taught to me by people who I had profound respect for and invested in me as a child. It is in the basic principles of the sport most games are either won or lost. Weaker opponents who display a better knowledge of the fundamentals can often defeat teams with stronger talent. Over a period of years, the game takes on a different shape, but the core principles of the game remain unchanged. At that stage of my coaching career, I could enjoy the progress a child made in his/her development of the sport, as much as I could enjoy winning. Something I learned in the process was coaches do not play the game. They simply prepare the others to play. It really does feel good to "see a plan come together."

Elton Trueblood, a Christian theologian, writes that the role of a pastor is similar to that of a coach. Both believe "practice makes perfect." It is almost impossible to be a successful coach without organization, knowledge, personnel, discipline, and a love for the game. These ingredients are also necessary to develop a congregation with a winning attitude toward the Christian lifestyle.

The biblical mandate for the pastor is to "Equip the Saints." Equipping the saints includes teaching the fundamentals of the Chrisitan faith. This is accomplished by the teaching and the preaching of God's Word. God provides the organization in which the equipping of the saints is to take place, the CHURCH. He also provides an abundance of knowledge in the Holy Scriptures. God is moving on the hearts of the people of our community. Therefore, He is providing the personnel. As God moves, the people who love the Lord will let it be known. "The Church Team" will only be complete by participating in training that will bring about discipline.

In this year's Annual Meeting on October 23rd at New Providence Baptist Church, you will hear how the life equipping experience helped a Saint prepare to witness to over one hundred struggling souls in Guatemala. You will travel the cobble stone roads of Las Union and witness the rescue of a family from the snare of Satan's destructive game plan. You will be amazed at the amount of food our churches provided for the unfortunate families at Las Mercedes.

Since 1830 the Sweetwater Baptist Association has been equipping saints to share the Gospel. The success of today is simply the results of faithful practice of the churches and their pastors over the years. There is no reason to change now. It is important that the biblical mandate to preach Jesus and Him crucified be maintained. It is also incumbent on us to pray that the Holy Spirit will convict us to continue to devote ourselves to the teaching of Christ. The Great Commission instructs us to be faithful in sharing the Good News at home and abroad until Christ's return. Let the FIRE burn within us!

Therefore, report to the coach Sunday morning ready for another round of practice. You never know when God will provide us the opportunity to participate in the game of life. Someone's eternal

Proposed changes for Proposed Budget for 2023-2024:

- Decrease Office Supplies by \$300.00 or a total of \$1680.00 (previously included Computer/Software)
- Add line item for Computer/Software for \$3000.00 (drastic increase in software programs for computers)
- Increase New Equipment and change name to New Equipment (including Computers) by \$3000.00 or a total of \$4000.00 (replacing current office desk top computers which are approximately 12 years old and 6 years old)
- Increase Evangelism by \$2500.00 or a total of \$5000.00 (provides funds for new vision for East Tennessee Evangelism Rally)
- Increase DOM by \$3005.00 (\$800.00 Salary; \$805.00 Housing; \$1200.00 Retirement; \$200.00 Christmas Gift)
- Increase Administrative by \$1423.00 (\$23.00 Salary; \$1200.00 Retirement; \$200.00 Christmas Gift)
- Increase Ministry Assistant by \$1315.00 (\$13.00 Salary; \$ 1102.00 Retirement; \$200.00 Christmas Gift)
- Increase Staff Social Security by \$210.00 or a total of \$5302.00

7 % overall increase with total increase of \$14,153.00; Total Proposed Budget \$217,422.00 In regards to the Contingency/Savings Account of the Sweetwater Baptist Association, the BUDGET/FINANCE COMMITTEE approved the following work projects totaling \$15,000-\$20,000 that were being considered or presented to the Trustees for approval:



- Approximately \$5000.00 for 20 x 24 carport cover for trailers; (SBA has \$3840.00 available funds in 2021 Golden Offering funds for this project.)
- \$5000.00 quote to install much needed security system (cameras, monitors, etc.) at building. Camera will be on back of building to point toward trailers.
- Quotes are being received for front door entrance area and door intercom system since two people have already fallen at building and others have stumbled at entry.

The Budget/Finance Committee also authorized the SBA Office to move \$50,000 from Contingency/Savings Account to a higher paying Money Market Savings Account for a best interest rate with a better yield on savings.


