

through unique gift shops. It is not unusual to see posted signs of warning.

especially in China or glassware shops. Often the eye level card is embossed with elegant handwriting, and reads, "DO NOT TOUCH." Other store owners use the brazen approach, "You break it, you buy it." There is something about these little pieces of sculpture that catches everyone's attention. Before one has time to resist the temptation, a hand reaches for the breakable item. We are not satisfied to admire the precious handiwork of the craftsman from a distance. We have to pick up the priceless ornament, turn it upside down, spin it around a couple of times, and then place it back where we found it. No wonder our children are confused when they start to reach for a bright colored object. Before the adult thinks, he shouts, "NO!" and slaps at the little hands. They are only repeating what they have learned from us. These types of stores bother me. The store owners know that when we enter their place of business, the first thing we are going to do is to touch something. I wonder if the store owners are hoping we will drop and break the item? Most of us cannot afford the price of such trinkets.

There is one type of store I feel safe in; the toy store. As a parent I feel such a relief when I first read the embossed card that begs: "PLEASE TOUCH." Looking around, the parent sees a train set on a little table. It does not have a card that says, "For Children Only." I am told that the train pushes so smoothly. Of course, I do not know for myself. It brings a smile to a parent's face to see all the children having an enjoyable time. There is no shouting from the parents, except when it comes time to leave.

"PLEASE TOUCH," I cannot help but believe these are the words our Heavenly Father would use. When Thomas questioned the reality of the resurrection of Jesus, he said he would not believe unless he could *touch* the nail prints in Christ's hand. About that time Jesus appeared in the room. What did He say to Thomas? "PLEASE TOUCH!" Our resurrected Lord is still standing with out-reached hands. He is reaching for you. Your pulse has quickened, your hands are wet, and your throat is dry; He is the one who speaks, "PLEASE TOUCH."

The seventy-five churches of the Sweetwater Baptist Association were represented by two mission teams in Guatemala and a team in Iowa. The purpose of these trips was to *touch* people for the cause of Christ. A total of fifty-three people willfully surrendered to God's will to invest their time, money, and talent into the hands of our Lord. God used the locals as well as these missionaries to introduce forty new converts into the kingdom of heaven, distribute bags of food to hungry people, provide medical treatment to hundreds of suffering individuals, and present the story of Jesus to a multitude of children.

There are forty-three children in Haiti that desperately need a touch of nourishment. The crisis situation in Haiti is causing a

desperate plea for food from the children in the orphanage the Sweetwater Baptist Association helped to start in 2010. Safe channels have been secured for sending money and purchasing food. We hope to raise enough funds to provide food for the children for approximately two years. Your generosity in providing in the past is an indication of what you can do now.
