

He Sends Us Forth was the theme for the 2025 Annual Meeting as we begin our steps toward the 200th Bicentennial Celebration in 2030.





Pastor Mitch Isbill presented the opening welcome and prayer for this year's meeting. Steve Pearson, Tennessee Baptist Mission Board, Harvest Field 4 Team Leader, shared a word of greetings and presented a plaque representing churches of the Sweetwater Baptist Association that participated in the Golden Mission

Offering. The Memorial Report included Dedication of the 2025 Minutes of the Association in memory of former pastors: Marvin "Bud" Millsaps and Jimmy Hollinghead. These men were beloved and faithful servants to this Association and our Lord. They will be sadly missed.

outstanding leadership. During the
Moderator's Message, he encouraged
us to fulfill *The Great Commission*.
We were blessed as Jeni Hinton,
Phillip Johnson and Darrin Nichols
from Fairview Baptist Tabernacle
Church shared special music for the

service, and Ben Curtis, *Music Director* from New Macedonia Baptist Church led the congregation in singing. In addition, Vice-Moderator Gabe Brannon did an exceptional job in leading the Business Session. Items approved by *Messengers* included: Gabe Brannon (Pastor of Union McMinn) will serve as Moderator and Rick Harris (Pastor of South Madisonville) was elected as Vice-Moderator for 2025-2026 and a proposed budget of \$226,958.00 was approved. The Director of Missions shared his 15th *Annual Report* with his vision going forward for *Individuals and Families; The Church, and The*

Association.

HAITI ORPHANAGE: In 2010, after a devastating earthquake, the Sweetwater Baptist Association of Churches partnered with Pastor Gaetan Alcegaire and the Yahve Shamma Orphanage in Haiti.
