Over the past few years, the Tennessee Baptist Convention has launched several new evangelistic



programs. Our office has strived to keep each church informed and offer materials, resources and training for the various outreach programs. I wanted to spend a few minutes of this month's article, outlining some of these programs.

- GOD'S PLAN FOR SHARING (GPS) The goal of GPS is to fulfill the Great Commission in Tennessee by the year 2020. "GPS" strives to see every believer sharing the Gospel, resulting in every person hearing the Gospel. "GPS" is outlined in detail on the TBC website (www.tnbaptist.org), but in laymen's terms, "GPS" is simply "sharing the Gospel". The programs outlined below (as well as many others) would all be considered "GPS" events or campaigns.
- MORE LIFE "More Life" is an evangelism/discipleship training program, designed to equip believers to practice "Relational Discipleship" and "Lifestyle Evangelism". "More Life" consists of two 8-week classes. The overall goal of "More Life" is for believers to do more evangelism and discipleship, which results in more lives committed to Christ and more Baptisms. Additional information and all the training materials for the "More Life" program are available on the TBC website (www.tnbaptist.org).
- HARVEST 1-5-1 "Harvest" focuses on reaching people or groups who choose not to attend church. A small group of 3-7 people from within the local church would form relationships with others (perhaps based on language or ethnicity, sporting activity or other common interest). Then they would begin a weekly Bible study/ministry meeting with their group (not at the church, not during regular church services). More than one group could be active at a time. The goal would be that each group would harvest five baptisms and another group would be formed from the first group, thus 1-5-1. Pastors interested in starting "Harvest" groups or wanting more information can contact our office or by calling the TBC at 1-800-558-2090.
- "MY HOPE WITH BILLY GRAHAM" In addition to these evangelistic programs, the Tennessee Baptist Convention is encouraging churches to participate in "MY HOPE WITH BILLY GRAHAM". "My Hope" is based on the apostle Matthew, who invited his friends to his home for a meal and to meet Jesus (Matthew 9:9-10). Dr. Graham has asked

believers to work throughout 2013 developing relationships with 3-5 non-believers. Then in November 2013 (in honor of Dr. Graham's 95th birthday), you would invite them to your home for a meal and to watch a broadcast, where Dr. Graham will share the Gospel with them and you will be given to opportunity to lead them to Christ. More information and training materials are available at www.myhopewithbillygraham.org.

"More Life", "Harvest" and "My Hope" are all programs that work within GPS. They each promote sharing the gospel (which is what GPS is all about). As you can see, there are many avenues available for our churches to evangelize the lost and disciple new believers. Some churches may focus on only one of these programs; some churches may want to pursue each of the various programs available through our state convention. Some churches will use other programs or devise their own evangelism strategy. The goal of each of these tools is simple...believers sharing the gospel with non-believers. Our office is happy to assist each of our pastors, churches and congregations in reaching this goal.

Now let me share an update from our recent mission trip to Haiti. The Lord uses willing hearts, open hands, and pliable spirits to accomplish much. That is the testimony of a recent weeks work in Haiti. God brought together eleven people from eight different churches from the Sweetwater Baptist Association to work with a team of like-minded Haitians. The amount of work produced and the lives that were touched will have an eternal effect on the participants. Haitian and American men and women worked side-by-side carrying block, mud and laying fifteen rows of cement block. Their efforts moved us a long way in constructing the multi-purpose building for the orphans.

God blessed in helping to cross language and cultural barriers. Such a project does not come without facing difficulties. We learn that from the study of the book of Nehemiah. His task was to rebuild the wall of Jerusalem after a long period of exile. Nehemiah continually struggled with opposition. Yet, God provided Nehemiah with the solution to complete the project and give glory to God. Those of us who journeyed to Haiti can testify that God's wisdom helped overcome all our human struggles.

The greatest praise that rose from the island of Haiti was the work our ladies did with the children. During the morning they worked with the school and helped to share Christ with over 130 children. In the afternoon, they provided a Vacation Bible School for the children of the orphanage. From the time we arrived for worship on Sunday until today, our ladies would say they left some of their heart in Haiti. The true blessing of this mission opportunity is that 20 children professed Christ as their Savior while we were there. Twenty new converts gave their heart to the great God of heaven. No wonder those ladies are still beaming. To those who have supported this mission effort with their prayers, financial gifts, wisdom, and energy, you have made an investment in the kingdom of God that will last forever.

HOPE FOR HAITI NEWS: In

February, a team of short-term mission volunteers from our Association of Churches traveled to Haiti to continue the ministry at the Foundation Vayeb Shamma

to Haiti to continue the ministry a the Foundation Yaveh Shamma for the Children Orphan in Haiti. After our team returned to the United States, the Haitian workers continued to work at the construction site. Photos indicate that the first floor of the building has now been poured with concrete. Additional construction teams will travel to Haiti in late fall to continue the work on the building.

Please pray for Pastor Gaetan Alcegaire and his ministry at Foundation Yaveh the Shamma for the Children Orphan in Haiti. Presently, our churches are helping to feed, clothe and house 32 orphans in Port-au-Prince, Haiti at the orphanage operated by Pastor Gaetan. We are encouraging families, churches, Sunday school classes, WMU groups or any group within a congregation to consider supporting a child at the









orphanage for \$80.00 a month. Many of our churches are responding to these urgent needs. Please pray how God would lead you to be part of this ministry.

This November will mark Billy Graham's 95th birthday and he has asked God for a great evangelistic thrust to coincide with this milestone. Even at age 95, Billy Graham continues to be a catalyst for the kingdom by his persistent pursuit of God and his enormous burden for the lost.

Last fall, I had the opportunity to spend a few days at the Billy Graham Training Center in Ashville, N.C. where I was introduced to MY HOPE WITH BILLY GRAHAM. This evangelistic effort was born in the heart of Dr. Graham and it caught fire in my own soul during that time of orientation.

MY HOPE is based on the example of the Apostle Matthew. Matthew invited his friends to his house for a meal and to meet Jesus. (Matt. 9:9-10).

Billy Graham has already been using this program in other countries and seen millions of people come to faith in Christ

The program is simple. Throughout the course of this year, Christians are asked to develop a relationship with 4-6 lost people. Then in November (in honor of Billy Graham's 95th birthday), these people will be invited into your homes for a meal and to watch a broadcast from Dr. Graham.
